Year 5 & 6 Mathematics

In mathematics we are working on fractions, percentages and decimals and their equivalents.

Activities you could try at home might include:

- Try drawing some pizza division examples using a compass and ruler and shade the slices in showing the fraction. Use squares if you'd prefer.
- Challenge yourself to write some random fractions and add them together remembering to ensure that the denominators are the same.
- Try multiplying random fraction by an integer (whole number) and year 6 could also try multiplying fractions remembering the rules of multiplying numerator by numerator and denominator by denominator.

Literacy

Find a poem about Christmas and practise reading it aloud at home. I would like all children to perform a poem in class in the final week of term. **This does not have to be from memory.**

Topic

We have been looking at Ancient Greece in both our literacy and topic work this term and have focused on the Greek gods and the stories of Perseus and Medusa, Theseus and the Minotaur and Daedalus and Icarus.

Please pick at least **one** tasks from the list below:

- Retell the story of Perseus and Medusa, Theseus and the Minotaur or Daedalus and Icarus as a comic strip.
- Write a character reference for one of the Greek gods applying for a job of your choice.
- Research the fashions of Ancient Greece and design your own clothing and footwear line.
- Build a working labyrinth with a Minotaur!
- Create a 'modern-day' Greek god/goddess.

Try to complete one task from each section. EVERYONE SHOULD FIND AND PREPARE A CHRISTMAS POEM.
