

## The Curriculum – Autumn Term 2 2017

As **historians** we will be researching Ancient Greece. We will investigate the timeline of the Ancient Greek civilisation, develop an understanding of the Ancient Greek Empire and find out about the Greek Gods and the various myths and legends associated with them.

In **literacy**, we will be working around our topic area and looking at the text 'Who let the Gods out?' by Max Evans. We will focus on Greek mythology and in turn, create our own myths in the style. We will create a play-script about the story of Daedalus and Icarus and we will also study some play-scripts depicting the Trojan Wars.

As **scientists**, we will be investigating the properties and changes of materials. We will test those properties, separate them where possible and study reversible and irreversible changes.

In **art and design**, we will study Ancient Greek artefacts and design our own Greek vases. We will explore different Greek foods. We will also create a labyrinth and a Trojan horse. We will design and create sock puppets to support our performances of Daedalus and Icarus.

As **mathematicians**, we will continue to develop and consolidate our existing skills and learn more about fractions, decimals and percentages as well as perimeter, area and geometry. We will take part in active maths sessions and reasoning and problem solving around these subject areas.

In **French**, we will engage in listening, speaking and writing activities learning how to talk about and describe ourselves.
